

**NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
FOR
COMPTON RENAISSANCE TRANSIT SYSTEM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Compton will receive proposals from qualified firms to operate the Compton Renaissance Fixed Route Transit system. The City of Compton desires to utilize the competitive procurement process for the provision of providing fixed route transit services described in the Request for Proposal (RFP).

The Compton Renaissance Fixed Route Transit system was inaugurated in October 1995 and developed in conformance with the Public Transportation section of the Circulation Element of the General Plan of the City of Compton. The Compton Renaissance Fixed Route Transit system was intended to serve as a feeder to the regional and sub-regional transit system for the residents of Compton and adjoining communities as well as the Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) Blue Line Light Rail Transit System and the Metropolitan Transportation Authority Regional Bus Transit System.

Proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk, City of Compton, 205 South Willowbrook Avenue, Compton, California, 90220 until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 07, 2024. POSTMARKS WILL **NOT** BE ACCEPTED. All proposals must be clearly marked, "PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE FIXED ROUTE TRANSIT SERVICES IN THE CITY OF COMPTON - DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL" and shall be delivered during the business hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday, except holidays, to the City Clerk's office.

Submit one original and four (4) copies and one copy on USB or CD of your fixed route transit proposals. It should be understood that the final annual costs will be as negotiated with the City.

All submitted proposals will be reviewed and analyzed by City staff and the proposal which best meets the City's need (s) will be selected for further analysis and negotiation.

The City of Compton proposes to enter into an Agreement for a three-year (3) term with two (2) one-year options.

The City of Compton reserves the right, in its sole discretion during this selection process, to reject any or all proposals or any portion without exception or explanation.

During this period of restricted contact, any attempt by a proposing firm, its representative or agent to contact, lobby, or make a representation to a member of the City Council, or any other official, employee, or agent of the City will be grounds for disqualification.
