Each year an assessment (\$54.00) for the maintenance of the City of Compton Sewer system is placed on your Property Tax Bill by Los Angeles County Tax Collector's Office.

If eligible you will be required to verify "Annually" that you still meet the Eligibility requirements of the City of Compton Sewer Assessment Exemption program. To apply for the City's Sewer Assessment Exemption program, please submit the application form and the following supporting documentation:

Please provide the following:

- **Proof of Age** (copy of valid California Driver's License, California Identification, Passport, or Birth certificate), **or**
- **Proof of Disability (if applicable)** if not 65 years of age (award letter documenting permanent disability from a State or authorized Agency), **and**
- **Proof of Ownership and Primary Residence** (a copy 2024-2025 Tax Bill showing "owner of record" with applicant name and property address)

(Below are some examples as to why an application will be denied)

- Secondary residences are ineligible for the sewer exemption
- Trust owned properties must provide the Trust Agreement showing applicant as Trustor
- Missing proof of permanent disability from a State or authorized agency will void the application
- Missing verifiable date of birth proof will void the application
- Missing a copy of the current property tax bill
- Name and address must match on all relevant documents
- Commercial Properties (i.e. Apartments, businesses, rental property) are ineligible for the exemption

The deadline for residents to submit their application and support documents for the upcoming Sewer Assessment Exemption is June 30th of this year.
