## **Home delivery for Homebound only**

### **Definition of Homebound Status**

A patient is considered homebound if they have a normal inability to leave their home due to illness or injury, and leaving home requires considerable effort. This does not mean the patient must be bedridden; rather, they may need assistance or the use of mobility devices (like walkers or wheelchairs) to leave home safely. Additionally, leaving home may exacerbate their condition or pose a risk to their health.

### **Certification statement**

The department stresses the importance of providing specific detail about the patient's condition and tells physicians what not to say: Further, I certify that my clinical findings support that this patient is homebound because: (e.g., cite specific clinical findings that make this individual homebound; do not use diagnosis, procedures or injuries alone; do not use terms like gait abnormality or weakness without specific clinical findings to explain fully., etc.)

This guidance helps physicians avoid vague language such as "require considerable and taxing effort" to justify homebound status.
