# NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

## FY 2026-2027 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The City of Compton expects to receive FY 2026-2027 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grant funds Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The City of Compton is authorized by HUD to distribute these funds to promote housing and community development for low- and moderate-income persons.

The City of Compton anticipates a HUD award of approximately \$127,600 based on the 2025-2026 allocation for the CDBG Program public service funds. The City expects to receive a reduced amount of HUD funds due to budget cuts. Note: These are estimates only.

### Who can apply?

- Organizations classified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt 501(c)(3);
- Organizations that have been in existence for at least two consecutive years;
- Projects that meet a HUD national objective and address a priority need identified by the City of Compton Consolidated Plan.
- Organizations that have matching funds from other sources.

Applications must be submitted by **5:00 pm, Thursday, January 15, 2026** to the **Office of the City Clerk**, City of Compton, 205 S. Willowbrook Ave., Compton, CA 90220. Postmarks, facsimiles, e-mails, and late applications will not be accepted. Remember to get a receipt for your application! Incomplete applications will not be allowed re-submittal.
