Welcome to the Recreation Department's Program and Event Guide!

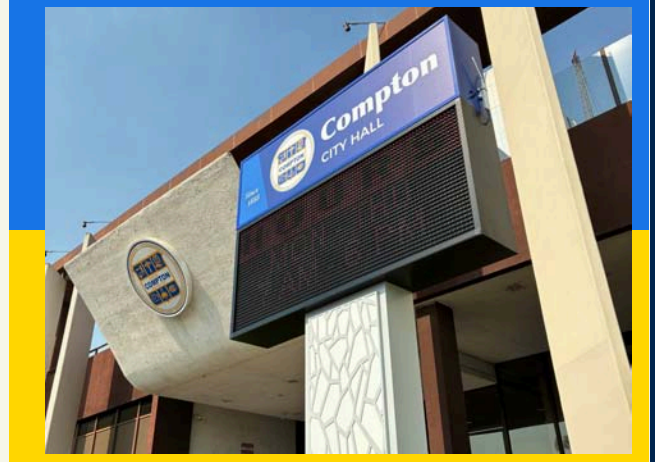
