TEMPORARY SIGN/BANNER PERMIT

(PERMIT MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION UPON REQUEST)

Section 30-22.5c. Temporary Sign Permits: The following temporary signs are permitted.

1. A temporary vinyl business identification sign for use by a business actively in the process of obtaining permits for permanent signage (six (6) month maximum). EXAMPLE: JOY'S BURGER PALACE.
2. A sign advertising a temporary use approved by a temporary use permit. EXAMPLE: XMAS TREE LOT
3. Banners advertising a promotional activity for a licensed business. Promotional banners shall be limited to one (1) banner per site for a maximum of thirty (30) days per permit. Such banners shall be affixed to the façade of the building holding the promotion and shall be no more than three (3) feet in height. EXAMPLE: FLAVOR OF THE MONTH – CHOCOLATE BOYSENBERRY, 2 SCOOPS FOR A \$1.00.
4. Special event for grand openings, sales carnivals, parades and charitable events for permits of less than two (2) acres for a maximum of thirty (30) consecutive days every six (6) months per calendar year. Streamers, flags, and spinners may be used in conjunction with special event signs. EXAMPLE: ST. PAUL'S MISSIONARY CHURCH SUMMER REVIVAL.
