



City of Compton Dial-A-Ride Program

Reasonable Modification

The City of Compton may allow the reasonable modification of our Dial-A-Ride transportation service to accommodate the special needs of persons with disabilities in order to allow them to fully utilize our Dial-A-Ride service.

Whenever possible a request for a reasonable modification or accommodation shall be filed in advance and submitted to the Dial-A-Ride representative, by email at contactpw@comptoncity.org, by telephone at 310-605-6224, or by mail at City of Compton, 205 South Willowbrook Avenue, Compton, CA 90220.

Request for reasonable modification or accommodations will not be approved if the request would: fundamentally alter the nature of the service, program, or activity; create a direct threat to the health or safety of others; result in an undue financial and administrative burden; or the individual would still be able to fully use the services provided by the City of Compton without the modification. Individuals with disabilities may file complaints regarding reasonable modification or accommodation with the Public Works Engineering Department by telephone at 310-605-6224 or via e-mail @ contactpw@comptoncity.org.
