

PUBLIC WORKS PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Street excavation permits are issued in accordance with Chapter XX of the Compton Municipal Code.
2. Sewer permits are issued in accordance with Sections – Chapter XXXIII inclusive of the Compton Municipal Code.
3. Driveway and sidewalk permits are issued in accordance with Sections 20-2 to 20-3.36 inclusive of the Compton Municipal Code.
4. All service connection excavations such as water, gas, and sewer must be completed in 24 hours. All other excavations must be completed in six days.
5. Barricades and flashing lights are to be maintained on all excavations, trenches, and obstructions.
6. Any concrete removal must be sawcut at the nearest scoreline.
7. Unless otherwise specified, trenches shall be placed with a minimum of one-inch or more base and paving materials than the existing pavement. In any case, the section shall be no less than 4" A.C. on 6" base.
8. Seventy-two hour advance notice is required for all construction. Email: PWInspections@comptoncity.org
9. Thirty-six hour advance notice is required for all inspections. Email: PWInspections@comptoncity.org
10. Forms and subgrade must be inspected and approved before ordering or placing concrete or asphalt.
11. Sewers and other pipelines must be inspected and approved before backfilled and the backfill must be compacted to Green Book Standards.
12. Sheriff and Fire Departments are to be notified in advance each day that the street is to be closed.
13. All excavations that involve cutting into existing Asphalt shall be patched and protected in accordance with The City of Compton Public Works Standard Details 151 and 152.

Additional Notes

Worker's compensation insurance and liability insurance naming the City as additional or co-insured must be on file with the City of Compton before a permit can be issued, also a letter of endorsement.

The City of Compton and other officers or employees hereof shall be saved harmless by the applicant from any liability or responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to persons or property, happening or occurring as the proximate result for any of the work undertaken under the terms of this application and the permit or permits which may be granted in response thereto, and that all of said liabilities are hereby assumed by the applicant. Traffic control plans are required.
