# NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

## FY 2020-2021 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The City of Compton received FY 2020-2021 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) grant funds **Community Development Block Grant Corona Virus Response (CDBG-CV)**. The City of Compton is authorized by HUD to distribute these funds to be used for specifically for the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 Coronavirus. This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, which was signed on March 27, 2020.

The City of Compton was awarded \$1,673,980 to fund the following programs:

- Small business loan or grant program job creation or retention: \$836,990
- Rental and Utility (electric/gas) assistance from loss of income: \$836,990

### Who can apply?

- Businesses with experience with small business assistance, and/or HUD related housing assistance programs

The City of Compton is accepting applications from organizations to help administer HUD programs to prevent, prepare, and respond to the Coronavirus. All applications that meet Compton's immediate community needs, a HUD National Objective, Eligible Activity, **AND** prevent, prepare for, or respond to the Coronavirus will be reviewed.
