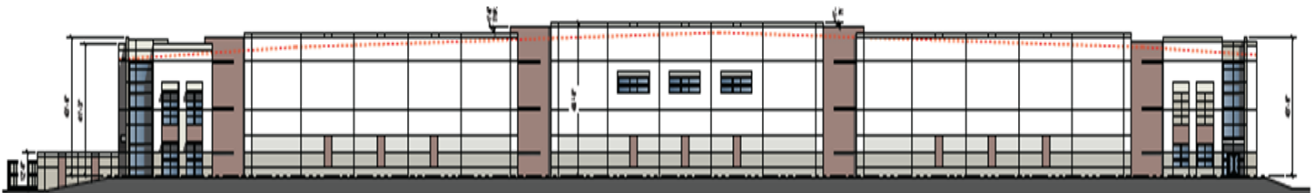
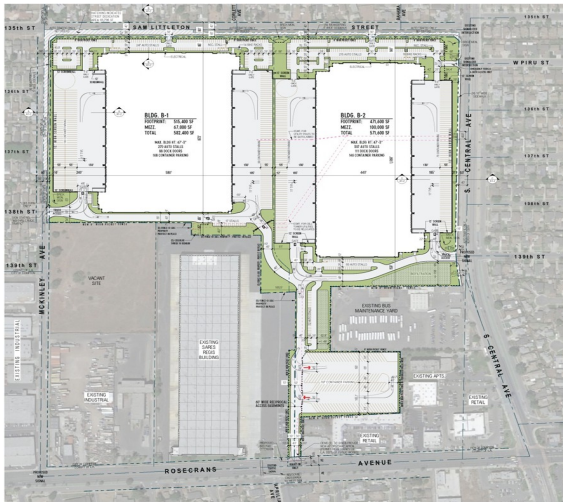

Brickyard Commerce Center Construction Begins!! Building Permits Issued November 10, 2015



Brickyard Construction Creating Local Jobs, Supporting Compton Businesses

Construction at the Compton Brickyard buildings will begin now that Building Permits were issued. Forty one app 41 out of 45 applicants for jobs have passed the initial screening process and will proceed to the next step. Three subcontractors working onsite have committed to local hiring in the community: CPS Security, Precision Engineering (Surveyor), and Boberg Engineering & Contracting (Earthwork). LA Brickyard is glad to report that, as of today, there are four Compton residents already working on site. CPS Security has three Compton residents and Boberg Engineering has one resident as a laborer on the project.

Although it's early in the construction process, LA Brickyard's general contractor, Millie & Severson, is in the process of contracting with Ralph Harvey Construction, a minority owned business, for construction of an eight-foot-tall construction barricade around the northern and western edges of the site. It has also contracted with a local firm, E-Nor Innovations, a minority owned business and member of the Compton Chamber of Commerce, for the traffic control work. E-Nor Innovations, a union shop, has a job-training program and can employ apprentices as needed for Traffic Control work. Millie & Severson will continue to work diligently with its subcontractors to reach out to qualified local companies to ensure that as many area businesses as possible can be involved in the project. Construction is expected to take 10 months.
