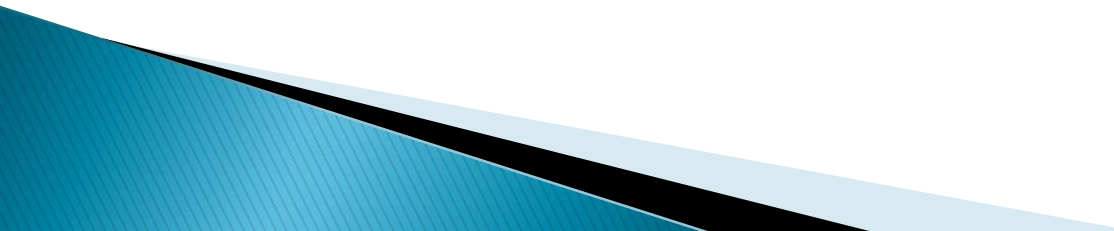

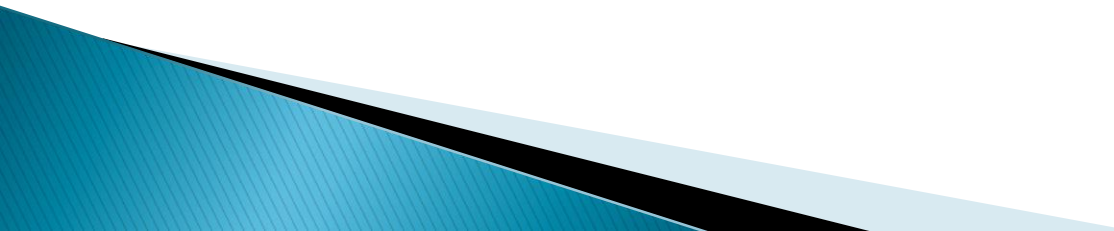

Project Background


- ▶ The 2021 Pavement Management Plan identified approximately 144 miles of “Fair” to “Very Poor” street condition categories citywide
 - ▶ In February 2021, the Public Works Department initiated the Road Repair Service Project
 - ▶ The Project was advertised on March 24th, & March 31st, 2021
- 

Scope of Services

▶ Project Description

- Pavement repairs such as pothole repairs and grind & overlay rehabilitation methods on distressed areas on designated streets
 - 40,000 square yards of pothole preparation
 - 10,000 tons of asphalt installation
 - 12 sewer manhole adjustments
 - 180 working days
- 

Tentative Project Construction Schedule

- ▶ Bid Advertisement March 24, 2021
 - ▶ Bid Opening April 22, 2021
 - ▶ Bid Award May 7, 2021
 - ▶ Construction Start June 7, 2021
 - ▶ Construction Completion December 3, 2021

Project Costs

- ▶ Total Project Cost – \$2,345,200
- ▶ FY 2020–2021 – \$643,000
- ▶ FY 2021–2022 – \$1,702,200
